

**CHARTER ORDINANCE NO. 14**

**A CHARTER ORDINANCE AMENDING CHARTER ORDINANCE NO. 10  
REGARDING THE TERM OF OFFICE FOR THE MAYOR.**

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE CITY OF  
LINN VALLEY, KANSAS:

Section 1. Ordinance No. 10, Section 4 is amended to read in its entirety:

“SECTION 4. General elections shall take place on the Tuesday succeeding the first Monday in November 2021. Succeeding elections will be held every two years for all such governing body positions whose terms have expired. A mayor and two council members shall be elected at one election and the remaining three council members shall be elected at the succeeding election. The mayor and council members shall have four-year terms.”

Section 2. This charter ordinance shall be published once a week for two consecutive weeks in the official City newspaper.

Section 3. This charter ordinance shall take effect 61 days after final publication unless a sufficient petition for a referendum is filed and a referendum held on the charter ordinance is provided in Article 12, Subsection (c)(3) of the Constitution of the State of Kansas, in which case the charter ordinance shall become effective if approved by the majority of the electors thereof

PASSED with at least two-thirds (2/3) vote of the entire governing body of the City of Linn Valley, Kansas this 8<sup>th</sup> day of February, 2021.
