## RESOLUTION NO. 109

## A RESOLUTION REQUESTING, THAT THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF LINN COUNTY, KANSAS SUBMIT TO THE QUALIFIED ELECTORS OF THE COUNTY, THE PROPOSITION OF LEVYING A TWO PERCENT (2.00\%) SALES TAX IN THE CITY OF LINN VALLEY, KANSAS.

WHEREAS, K.S.A. 12-187 et seq., and amendments thereto, authorizes the Board of County Commissioners to submit to the qualified electors of the county the question of levying a citywide retailer's sales tax to be collected by the state department of revenue with revenue therefrom returned and distributed as provided by law within this city; and,

WHEREAS, the Governing Body of Linn Valley, Kansas has determined that additional revenue is needed for a fire truck, city building construction and such other general governmental purposes as may be in the best interest of the city and that property tax increases should be avoided, if possible; and desires to submit the ballot language identified below to the electors of Linn Valley, Kansas on the August 2, 2022, ballot,

## NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE CITY OF LINN VALLEY, KANSAS:

SECTION 1. The Governing Body of Linn Valley, Kansas submits the following language to be placed on the August 2, 2022, ballot by the Linn County Election Commission:
"Shall the City of Linn Valley, Kansas be authorized to levy a two percent (2.00\%) citywide retailers' sales tax for the purpose of additional revenue for public safety, city facilities, and such other general governmental purpose as may be in the best interest of the city; as authorized by K.S.A. 12-187, et seq., and amendments thereto?"

## BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED:

That the Board of County Commissioners is hereby requested to submit such question to the electors at an election to be held on the $2^{\text {nd }}$ day of August 2022, with such tax to take effect on the $1^{\text {st }}$ day of January 2023, if approved by a majority of the electors voting thereon.
